GROWTH OF ALUMINIUM DIE CASTING SECTOR IN INDIA

India's aluminum die-casting industry thrives on automotive and electronics demand, expected to grow over 8.8% from 2020 to 2026. Rising incomes drive auto sales and component demand, while technology advances increase the need for die-cast products in electronics.



AUTOMOTIVE

- India aims to double its auto industry size to \$179.4 Bn by the end of 2024
- India aims for a 30% Electric Vehicle penetration by 2030, with its EV market projected to grow at a 45.5% CAGR from 2022 to 2030
- · Value of the Auto Components industry to reach \$300 Bn by 2026

CONSUMER DURABLES

- The appliances and consumer electronics industry, dominated by ACs, refrigerators, and LEDs is projected to hit \$21.18 Bn by 2025


